



Fink honored with First Amendment Award

Attorney Herschel Fink of Detroit was one of three people honored by SPJ with the 2010 First Amendment Award. Fink was recognized for his work to keep Detroit Free Press reporter David Ashenfelter out of jail after Ashenfelter refused to reveal his sources.

Dave Cuillier, a professor at the University of Arizona, was also honored for his work as chair of the Freedom of Information committee.

Carol Rosenberg, a reporter at the Miami Herald, was the third recipient. She fought for access to public records regarding the Guantanamo Bay controversy.
